



1. Apply the parking brake




2. Using a small flat-bladed tool, remove the bezel from the ignition switch cylinder.



- 3. If the vehicle is equipped with a column shift, position the transaxle shift control indicator to 1. Keep the key in the ignition switch cylinder.
- 4. Adjust the steering wheel for access.
- 5. Remove the steering wheel filler panel



6. Remove the instrument panel (I/P) fuse block access hole covers.



- 7. Remove the screws from the I/P cluster trim plate.
- 8. Starting at the right end of the I/P cluster, grasp the trim plate and pull rearward.
- 9. Continue working around the I/P cluster trim plate until all of the retainers are released from the I/P trim pad.
- 10. Disconnect the electrical connectors from the hazard switch and from the traction control switch, if equipped.
- 11. Remove the I/P cluster trim plate.
- 12. After removing the trim plate bezel simply remove the four ¼" screws holding the instrument cluster in place. Pull the cluster out and unplug the single wiring harness connection in the back.
