



- 1. Adjust the steering wheel for access.
- 2. Using a small flat-bladed tool, remove the bezel from the ignition switch cylinder.




- 3. Remove the access cover from the left instrument panel (IP) fuse block.
- 4. Remove the steering column filler.
- 5. Open the IP compartment door.



6. Remove the screw from the left side of the IP cluster trim plate.



- 7. Remove the screw from the right side of the IP cluster trim plate
- 8. If the vehicle is equipped with a front floor console, position the transaxle shift control lever to the rear most position.



10. After removing the trim plate bezel simply remove the four ¼" screws holding the instrument cluster in place. Pull the cluster out and unplug the single wiring harness connection in the back.
